Complete Project Description:

The Fr. Ray Children's Village was opened (in 2008) with the aim of providing a home for poor, abused and neglected young children. The children live in a homely atmosphere with other children who become their brothers and sisters, all taken care of by a specially trained 'mother' and 'aunt'. Providing this kind of environment for the children to grow can only be of benefit as the children develop into teenagers and young adults.

With the start-up operation of the Fr. Ray Children's Village underway, there are currently 26 children in our Home, of whom 22 are attending classes at various schools located in different areas of Pattaya. In 2009, we will build another 4 houses adding another 26 to 30 children to this project. We feel that the addition of a "16 seater" van would greatly facilitate our transportation of the new children to and from their schools.

In order to alleviate our existing transportation problem, the Father Ray Foundation is seeking funding to purchase a van. This vehicle will not remain idle during the day while the children are in school, as it will also be used for the following:-

1. Used as an Emergency vehicle to transport children and staff to and from the hospital.
2. Transporting small groups of children to outside venues on weekend activities.
3. Transporting staff and children to the various project sights.
4. Picking up our children who sometimes have to stay late at school.
5. Facilitating necessary travelling outside the home both for the children and for staff's work operations.
